Scope and Contents

Charles L. Pulliam was a mathematics teacher at the Indiana State Normal School during the late 1890's. He later earned his law degree and established a practice at 515 Ohio Street in Terre Haute. Pulliam served as Vigo County Circuit Court Judge from 1915-1920.

The collection consists of one bound volume which served a dual purpose while in Pulliam's possession. The first portion of the volume contains minutes of the Indiana State Normal School faculty, while the remaining pages are devoted to Pulliam's personal journal entries.
