



Community Service Federal Work Study Opportunity

Midwest Campus Compact Citizen-Scholar Fellowship Program (M3C)

What is the Citizen-Scholar Fellowship Program? Citizen-Scholar Fellows are undergraduate students who are dedicated to making a difference in their communities. Each fellow makes a commitment to complete 300 hours of community service with a host non-profit organization within a 1-year or less period.

When does the program start? Openings are available for the 2008-09 class of Citizen-Scholar Fellows with service. The enrollment periods are August 15 – October 31, 2008 and January 15 – March 31, 2009. M3C Fellows will complete their service within one year of their enrollment date.

Who is eligible? Students at Indiana State University who have received a Federal Work Study award are eligible to apply.

What are the benefits of participating in the program? This program allows students to complete their work study placement at a local non-profit organization while earning an additional \$1000 education award from AmeriCorps (Corporation for Community and National Service).
